

## **Vernon Building Society Charity Calendar Photography Competition Terms and Conditions 2017**

1. This competition is open to UK residents. Entrants under 18 years of age should have written permission from their parent or guardian prior to submitting an entry.
2. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. Photographs must feature subject matter in Stockport and the surrounding area and the location of the photograph should be identified in the entry.
4. Entries should be uploaded to the '2018 Calendar Competition' section of the Vernon's Facebook page ([www.facebook.com/vernonbuildingsociety](http://www.facebook.com/vernonbuildingsociety)) with details of the location where the image was taken in the caption. Alternatively, entries can be submitted by email to [photographycomp@thevernon.co.uk](mailto:photographycomp@thevernon.co.uk)
5. Photos should be submitted at high resolution, at least 5MB.
6. All entries must be received by 4<sup>th</sup> October 2017.
7. All images submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe on the copyright of any third party or any laws. Entrants must warrant that the photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it.
8. Copyright in all images submitted for this competition remains with the respective entrants. However, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to Vernon Building Society to feature any or all of the submitted images in any of their publications, their website and/or in any promotional material connected to this competition.
9. Winners' photographs will be featured in the Vernon Building Society 2018 calendar which will be sold through the Vernon's branches with all profits going to the Jubilee Fund which sponsors charity and community groups for the benefit of the Stockport area. Winning entrants may be contacted through Facebook or email and asked to provide name and contact details.
10. The entrant whose image is chosen for the front page will receive a £100 Love2Shop voucher.
11. The winners may be requested to take part in publicity such as press photographs, news items or photographs on the Society website. Personal details – other than name and town or village of residence – will not be shared with any third party.
12. The following four criterion will be used by the shortlisting panel to assess entries: Composition, Originality, Public Appeal and Suitability for Inclusion.
13. The decision of the Vernon Building Society is final.
